**To complete your application and confirm eligibility, please bring the following documents to your local ABCD site. (See Reverse)**

### Age/Identification

- Social Security Card **AND**
- US Birth Certificate **OR** US Passport **OR** USCIS Card-Documents CANNOT be expired as of 6/25/2018

### Residency

- Preprinted bill or postmarked envelope dated within the last 30 days - bill of any household member

### Household Size

- Birth certificates for every household member **OR**
- Health insurance cards for every household member **OR**
- One of the following documents with **every household member listed**:
  - Public Assistance Letter - Dated within the last 6 months
  - Signed 2017-2018 Lease / Landlord Statement

### Household Income

- Housing & Urban Development Sheet – Current Year
- Pay stubs – (biweekly pay = 2 pay stubs, weekly = 4 pay stubs) – dated within the last 30 days
- Current Social Security Statement – dated this year
- Current Transitional Aid to Families with Dependent Children letter from the Department of Transitional Assistance – dated last 6 months
- If type of income is not listed, please contact Youth Services for further assistance

- Signed Application
- CORI Release Form
- If you are male and 18 or older you must register for the selective service at [sss.gov/regist.htm](http://sss.gov/regist.htm)
